## CHART DEFINITIONS

### SCHOOL PERFORMANCE:

**H.P. High Performing:** School met 2011 index score objectives.

**M.P. Moderately Performing:** School met 2005-2006 targets (for index scores, graduation rate, test participation rate).

**I.P. Insufficient Progress:** School did not meet 2005-2006 targets.

**(w/C) With Caution:** High performing or moderately performing school that has missed up to three testing targets. Can retain this classification for only one year.

**+ Regents Commended:** School has improved testing scores significantly over the previous two years or has achieved exceptionally high scores.

### INDEX SCORES:

The school's average scores on statewide, standardized tests (out of 100).

\*school not open '01-'02, scores from '02-'03.

\*\*school not open '01-'02, scores from '03-'04.

\*\*\*school not open '01-'02, scores from '04-'05.

### SAT:

The Scholastic Aptitude Test, required for admission to many colleges.

### AP COURSES AND TESTS:

Advanced Placement (AP) courses are college-level courses that prepare students to take Advanced Placement tests. If a student achieves college proficiency level on the tests, some colleges may grant them credit.

### SUSPENSION RATE:

This rate is the number of suspension incidents per 100 students; a suspension rate over 100 reflects the fact that some students are suspended more than once.

### DRUG, CIGARETTE AND ALCOHOL USE:

These percentages are based on a survey given to students.

### HIGHLY QUALIFIED TEACHER:

This classification is based on standards set by the Federal No Child Left Behind Act.

### INSTRUCTIONAL SPENDING:

Costs directly related to supporting the child, the teacher or the classroom.
