Nearly seventy years later, the Arden nameplate has evolved into a multi-faceted group of geographically diverse firms that comprise Arden Building Companies — headquartered in Pawtucket, Rhode Island. Arden employs over 440 office and union craft personnel in Rhode Island, Massachusetts, Connecticut and Maine.

1954
Robert H. Bolton (RH Bolton) joins Arden working as a union pipefitter and eventually oversees that installation projects as a senior project manager. Cameron J. Purvillo joins Arden with a strong engineering background in power piping and process systems. Purvillo develops a quality assurance program which leads to Arden obtaining ASME certifications. In 1968, Irwin's son Peter Arden becomes president, and RH Bolton is appointed general manager.

1978
Peter Arden focuses the company on mechanical construction. He also invests in new world technology — the computer — streamlining job costs, accounting, and estimating procedures.

1981
RH Bolton is promoted to executive vice president and appoints Cameron J. Purvillo as vice president. Robert M. Bolton (RMB), his son, joins Arden as a project engineer after graduating college.

1982
In 1982, Bob becomes vice president and adds a service and maintenance division. After graduating, John Purvillo, CJ Purvillo's son, joins Arden as a project engineer. John plays an integral part in the success of Arden Engineering Constructors, spanning over thirty years to his current role as president.

1989
In 1989, RH Bolton purchases Arden, partnering with CJ Purvillo, forming Arden Engineering Constructors, Inc. focusing on HVAC, industrial power and environmental applications.

1999
In 1999, Arden is sold to PSEG Energy Technologies, Inc.

2006
PSEG sells the mechanical construction market, and Bob purchases the company, forming Arden Engineering Constructors, LLC. Bob expands Arden's offerings and market diversification by adding plumbing, pipe fabrication, fire protection and electrical contracting. He also invests in state of the art technology.

2008
In 2008, Arden Building Companies is formed as a parent company in response to the growth and expanding geography of business acquisitions. MA, OH, Waterbury, Connecticut, 2008, Lingue Mass Works, Pawtucket, Rhode Island, 2008, and Coppola Mechanical of New England, Tewksbury, Massachusetts, 2014.

2018
In 2018, Bob's sons join Arden Building Companies: Doug Bolton as a project manager at AEC, and Connor Bolton as a project manager at CMAC.

2020
In 2020, John Purvillo is named President of AEC, and Bob becomes CEO of ABC.

2022
In 2022, Bob becomes president of the Mechanical Contractors Association of America (MCAA), following his election to board of directors in 2018.
